Applying for grants

The board considers grant applications that focus on:

- projects by national and international institutions that contribute to the prevention and/or control of tuberculosis worldwide;
- scientific education and research into the prevention and/or control of tuberculosis.

The board has the discretionary power to deviate from the above criteria where appropriate.

Grant applications are discussed at a board meeting. Grant applications must be submitted before 1 May.

The available grant budget will be allocated in order of receipt of the grant applications and according to relevance and quality. Please send your application to the following email address: info@gravenhaagsetbc.nl

The granting or rejection of a grant application will be communicated in writing after the board meeting. If the board has deferred the application, it will be communicated in writing what additional information is required in order to assess the application in an informed manner.

A grant application must meet the following requirements:

- a clear and concrete description of the use of the requested grant amount and its relevance to tuberculosis control or prevention, including an explanation of its feasibility;
- a detailed financial budget of the total project costs and the financial resources required;
- the amount requested is a maximum of EUR 50,000;
- the requested grant amount must be reasonably proportionate to the intended objective;
- the requested financial support is not provided in any other way;

- For each grant request awarded, an annual progress report and a final report on the project results achieved are required, including a detailed overview of the costs incurred and the benefits.
